Here's the basic rules - The put together contest can be made up of active or inactive Harmonizers and can include one non-Harmonizer (so yes, you can try to get that buddy you sing with in church to sing and find out how much fun this hobby can be). If more than one member of the quartet is in a CURRENTLY registered quartet(s), only one member of the put-together quartet may sing the part that they sing in any of their currently registered quartet(s). WE DO, HOWEVER, ENCOURAGE REGISTERED QUARTET MEMBER TO TAKE THE LEAD IN PUTTING TOGETHER SOME QUARTETS AND ENCOURAGING MEMBERS WHO HAVEN'T TRIED QUARTETING TO GIVE IT A WHIRL BEFORE WHAT IS ALWAYS ONE OF THE MOST APPRECIATIVE AUDIENCES EVER!
