The use in any quartet of more than one member of a registered quartet is prohibited; exceptions may be made if parts are switched. The competitors tonight have never sung together publicly as quartets in these combinations. Sometimes Put Together quartets "stick together" when the contest is finished - we hope this may be the case with at least some of the quartets you hear tonight.
